**Project Location** The project is located at Trancas Creek on Pacific Coast Highway between post mile 56.5 and 57.5. The project is within the City of Malibu in Los Angeles County of Los Angeles, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0117-R5 to update the project description to include snap docks as a method of protecting streamflow and allowing seasonal work window extensions with CDFW written approval, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code. The project Applicant is the California Department of Transportation.
