Project Title: Cordilleras Health System Replacement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0064-R3, Major Amendment)

Project Location: The project is located at Cordilleras Creek, a tributary to the San Francisco Bay, in the County of San Mateo, State of California; Latitude 37.473483, Longitude -122.269253; Section 27, Township 5S, Range 4W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Woodside; 200 Edmonds Road, Redwood City, CA 94062; Assessor's Parcel Number 050-470-050.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Major Amendment to Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0064-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the County of San Mateo, Planned Development Unit.

The major amendment for the project includes the removal of an in-channel concrete wall that obstructs creek flows and the replacement of an existing 48-inch diameter concrete culvert with a ten-ft wide D-shaped aluminum culvert with a roughened channel bed, and channel restoration at the culvert inlet and outlet.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 10/29/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
