Project Location: The project is located at the Little Break Wetland Central Slough and Central Slough Channel, a tributary to the San Joaquin River, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 38.0130937057153°, Longitude -121.742981408318°, Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 2 East, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Jersey Island, Mt. Diablo meridian, 6000 Bridgehead Road, Oakley, CA 94561.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0049-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Chemours Company FC, LLC, as represented by Steve Shoemaker.

The project is part of a larger action involving implementation of a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act corrective action to remedy soil, sediment, and groundwater contamination that resulted from former manufacturing at the site. Project activities authorized by this Agreement cover remediation activities in the Central Slough and Central Slough Channel and includes removal and/or remediation of sediment through mechanical dredging, installation of temporary coffer dams and silt fencing, dewatering, culvert removal, temporary placement of protective mats, and site restoration and revegetation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 31, 2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
