**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located at Parcel No. 040-002-027-000 on private property belonging to a Mr. Roland and Mrs. Franziska Schabram; Latitude 38.219752, Longitude - 120.776577, at an unnamed tributary to Young’s Creek in the County of Calaveras, California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0123-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The Project will construct mitigation for the SR-4 Wagon Trail Realignment Project (1600-2020-0104-R2) on an unnamed tributary to Young’s Creek. Construction of a pond, berm, irrigation system, and plantings will be completed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
