**Project Location/City/County:** The project is located on the Garden Hwy beginning at approximately 100 feet north of Farm Road and ending approximately 165 feet north of Bryte Bend Road, in Sacramento County.

**Project Description:** Approval of Permit No. 19684, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To approve temporary placement of ATT communication lines between Farm Road and Bryte Bend Road. The communication lines are to be attached to the existing wooden poles, previously permitted under Board Permit 19637. The scope of work does not include any underground work. This utility relocation project is required for the Natomas Basin Civil Works Project.

This is to advise that the Central Valley Flood Protection Board, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above described project on **October 21, 2022** and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
