Project Location/Address/City/County: Located along the Garden Highway approximately 1.62 miles south from the intersection of Garden Highway and Interstate 5, in Sacramento County.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To authorize an existing paved/gravel ramp on the landside of the east bank of the Sacramento River, at Levee Mile 10.03, at station 530+00 (Stations Reference to NLIP). The ramps are comprised of miscellaneous fill and its surface is comprised of asphalt at the top of the ramp nearest to the levee and aggregate base on the lower portion of the ramp. This work is associated with NLIP under Master Permit 18159-7, authorized on March 30, 2011.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
