PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) is a responsible agency for this project. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Program is providing funds for the project. The City of Fresno proposes to install a new 6 MG tank to provide a total of 7.5 MG of storage capacity at the Northeast Surface Water Treatment Facility.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The SWRCB approved the project described above on June 28, 2019. The City of Fresno will be carrying out the project.

The SWRCB has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on water quality.
2. The project **will** have a significant effect on the environment.
3. An **Environmental Impact Report and Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration** was prepared for this project pursuant to the provision of CEQA.

5. Findings **were** made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was** adopted for this project.
