**Project Title:** Bradmoor Island and Arnold Slough Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SOL-13808-R3)

**Project Location:** The Project is located in the northeastern section of Suisun Marsh, approximately 8.5 miles southeast of the City of Fairfield, at a Latitude 38.190841, Longitude -121.921019, in Solano County.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SOL-13808-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Department of Water Resources.

The Bradmoor Island and Arnold Slough Restoration Project will restore tidal hydrology to approximately 607 acres on Bradmoor Island and approximately 137 acres at Arnold Slough. Project activities include breaching levees in strategic locations, grading down sections of levees, filling ditches near breach locations, stockpiling excess levee material, removing debris, and vegetation management.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency approved the above-described project on April 9, 2021 and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
