Project Title: French Bar Road Bridge Replacement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2016-0117-R2 Extension)

Project Location (include county): The French Bar Road Bridge Replacement Project is located on South Fork Jackson Creek, a tributary to Jackson Creek, in the County of Amador County, State of California, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map "Jackson"; Latitude 38°20'39.21"N, Longitude 120°45'58.45"W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has extended Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0117-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Jackson, as represented by Gary Ghio. The project is limited to the replacement of the French Bar Road Bridge over Jackson Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described extension to the Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
