The 2017 Supplemental EIS/EIR identified several areas of controversy based on the comments received during the public scoping period and the history of the NEPA and CEQA processes undertaken by USACE, CVFPB, and the SAFCA. Several of these areas of controversy are applicable to the Project, including:

- The current design eliminated the pedestrian detour at MIAD (described in the 2017 Supplemental EIS/EIR) due to construction safety concerns.
- Increased traffic through the Douglas Boulevard entrance for construction of Dikes 1-3.
