Project Location (include county): The project is located at three unnamed tributaries to Laguna Creek, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.455998, Longitude -121.298607 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees); Assessor's Parcel Number 122-0110-019-0000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SAC-47643-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, AKT Silver Springs, LLC.

The project is limited to the construction of three outfalls in the tributaries of Laguna Creek. This project is part of the larger Silver Springs East Project which includes the development of a residential community and associated infrastructure within a 92-acre property with 39 acres planned for constructing single-family homes and connections to existing multi-use trails. Project activities include excavation and concrete pouring in the channel.
