The proposed project would allow for an update to the closure date for the existing, operational Olinda Alpha Landfill. The closure date would be updated from December 31, 2021 to December 31, 2036. The landfill is taking longer to fill up than originally anticipated due to increased recycling and waste diversion.

The project will result in an update of the landfill closure date only, which will not result in any new significant environmental impacts that were not previously identified and analyzed under Final EIR 588. The final development plan approved under Final EIR 588 will remain unchanged. Environmental impacts analyzed under Final EIR 588 have not changed, Olinda Alpha landfill is just taking longer to fill up than originally estimated due to increased recycling and waste diversion.
