Based on the Initial Study, the project would not have a significant effect on the environment. Largely, the environmental impacts associated with the proposed project would be the same as or similar to those identified in the Eastern Dublin Specific Plan (EDSP) EIR and mitigated to less-than-significant levels with implementation of the mitigation measures identified in the EDSP EIR. New impacts were identified in the following environmental areas: air quality and noise. None of these impacts would result in significant effects that cannot be mitigated to less-than-significant levels with implementation of project-specific mitigation measures identified in the Initial Study. Therefore, the City has determined that the proposed project requires a Supplemental Mitigated Negative Declaration, in compliance with PRC Section 21166 and CEQA Guidelines Section 15163.

Project-Specific MM AIR-1: During construction of the proposed project, the project contractor shall ensure all off-road diesel-powered construction equipment of 50 horsepower or more used for the project construction at a minimum meets the California Air Resources Board Tier 2 emissions standards equipped with Level 3 diesel particulate filters or the equivalent.

Project-Specific MM-NOI-1: Construction Vibration Damage. Due to the close proximity to surrounding structures, the City of Dublin (City) Director of Community Development, or designee, shall verify prior to issuance of demolition or grading permits, that the approved plans require that the construction contractor to implement the following noise reduction measures during project construction activities to ensure that damage does not occur at surrounding structures should heavy equipment be necessary within 15 feet of surrounding structures:
