Project Title: Long Beach Municipal Urban Stormwater Treatment (LB-MUST)

Project Location (attach map, if applicable): Multiple pump stations and streets near the eastern shore of the lower Los Angeles River in the City of Long Beach.

Purpose of the Project: Increasing the volume of water available to treat at the Long Beach Municipal Urban Stormwater Treatment (LB-MUST) facility.

Project Description: Collect storm water from a minimum of one thousand one hundred (1,100) acres of impermeable surfaces. The Project shall be designed to convey a minimum of two and seven tenths (2.7) cubic feet per second for treatment at the LB-MUST facility.

The Project includes (List major tasks): Install pipeline, pumps, and appurtenances to convey stormwater from Pump Stations LA-01, LA-F14, and LA-03 to the LB-MUST facility. Optimize and integrate mechanical and process controls at stormwater pump stations and the LB-MUST facility necessary to treat new sources of stormwater.
