Project Description: The Natomas Unified School District as lead agency approved a project called the Paso Verde School, which will be constructed and operated by Natomas Unified School District, with capacity to accommodate up to approximately 1,000 students. The Natomas Unified School District Trustees approved the project on March 13, 2019. The City of Sacramento, acting as a responsible agency under CEQA, determined to provide a water supply to the Natomas Unified School District, which will use it to provide water service to Paso Verde School.

This is to advise that the City of Sacramento, City Council has approved the above described responsible agency action on June 25, 2019 and has made the following determination regarding the above described project:

1. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared and certified for this project by lead agency Natomas Unified School District (SCH 2008052079) pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. The project title in the Environmental Impact report (draft and final) is "Paso Verde School."
2. Mitigation Measures were made a condition of the approval of the project.
3. A Mitigation Monitoring Plan was adopted for this project.
4. A statement of Overriding Considerations was adopted for this project.
5. Findings were made pursuant to the CEQA section 15091.
6. As responsible agency the City of Sacramento's provision of a water supply will not have a significant effect on the environment.
