Project Description: This project consists of a proposed cannabis cultivation operation in Trinity County, California with proposed development of temporary hoop house mixed light operations. The site comprises approximately 31,380 ft<sup>2</sup> of total area. There is currently an outdoor cultivation area, 70'x100' (7,000 sqft mature/immature cultivation area) which utilizes approximately 280 4'x4' grow bags on the ground, 1' between bags. Proposed future development will consist of installation of temporary hoop houses/permitted permanent greenhouses within the developed footprint. The proposed cultivation operations will consist of a combined cultivation area of 19,000 ft<sup>2</sup> (10,000 ft<sup>2</sup> mature cultivation area, 9,000 ft<sup>2</sup> of immature growth). Proposed infrastructure includes: four (4) temporary hoop houses/permanent greenhouses 30'x100' (2,500 sqft canopy each) for mature, three (3) temporary hoop house/permanent greenhouses for immature cultivation, and one (1) 8' x 40' container for packaging and processing, harvest storage, waste storage and administration hold area. The site license will be classified as "Adult-Use Small Mixed Light" with an immediate plan to continue to use the outdoor cultivation areas and then utilize temporary hoop houses/greenhouses for all cultivation areas in the subsequent seasons. Water is supplied by a permitted groundwater well and pump that is currently installed on the property, with three to five water storage tanks to be installed. The property will utilize a permitted septic system serviced routinely as needed.



The County finds that the adoption of the proposed project falls within the Trinity County Cannabis Program Environmental Impact Report ("EIR")( SCH# 2018122049). Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR. No further environmental review is required because the County finds, based on substantial evidence in the Record of Proceedings, that approval of this project is a "later activity" associated with the Cannabis Program EIR, as defined by subsection (c) of Section 15168, in that (i)all impacts associated with the approval of this project are within the scope of environmental review previously studied, and (ii) the requirements and mitigations required by Chapter 17.43 and 17.43G of the Trinity County Code, adequately serve to mitigate the impacts associated with approval of this project.
