**Project Title: Milena Maskovic** (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0306-R1)

**Project Location (Trinity):** The project to be completed is located within the Mad River watershed, approximately 6.9 miles southeast of the town of Dinsmore, County of Trinity, State of California. The project is located in Sections 27 and 28, T1N, R6E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Sporthaven U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 018-740-001

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2017-0306-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Milena Maskovic**.

The project is limited to four encroachments, two encroachments are for water diversion, one from an unnamed tributary to the Mad River, and the second from the Mad River main stem. Water is diverted for irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include modification, use, and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The two other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replace with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

**Notice of Determination**

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 25, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
