**Project Title:** Nyiakub Yang Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-07771-R1

**Project Location (Trinity):** The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Carr Creek in Trinity County, CA; T31N, R11W, Section 3, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Hayfork quadrangle, County Assessor's Parcel Number 017-450-15-00, 780 Nelson Road, Hayfork.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-07771-R1-R1, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Nyiakub Yang.

The project consists of two projects, 1) the removal of an existing seep well and restoration of a segment of ephemeral stream channel, and 2) the replacement of the overflow spillway mechanism on an existing impoundment of an ephemeral stream.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on July 23, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).

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- 3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
