Project Location (Trinity): The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Van Duzen River in the County of Trinity, State of California. The project is located at Section 20, Township 02S, Range 07E, Ruth Lake U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle, Humboldt Base & Meridian, Trinity County APN 020-510-020-000, 10381 Ruth-Zenia Road in Hettenshaw Valley.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-23550-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Severin Stoyanov**.

The project consists of the maintenance and placement of erosion protection for one single-culvert stream conveyance and the armoring of one ford-style crossing on an unnamed ephemeral tributary to Road Gulch Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 19, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
