Project Title: Diversion and Culvert Replacement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0763-R1)

Project Location (Trinity): The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Devil's Gulch Creek in Trinity County, CA. The point of diversion (POD) is located at Section 30, Township 32N, Range 10W, Hayfork Summit U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Trinity County Assessor's Parcel Number 015-130-038-000, 1485 Devil's Gulch Road, Hayfork.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2019-0763-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Anahat Singh, representing **Trinity Alpine Cannabis, LLC**.

The project consists of the replacement of an existing culvert and the continued use of an existing surface water diversion on a tributary to Devil's Gulch Creek. The diversion is for domestic uses only.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 6, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).

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- 3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
