Project Location (Trinity): The project is located at Reading Creek, a Class I tributary to Trinity River, in the County of Trinity, State of California; Street address 1141 Blanchards Flat Road, Douglas City, CA, 96024; Latitude 40.597414N, Longitude -122.905341W; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 015-190-017-000.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-23629-R11), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Toma Vaglariski**.

The project is limited to the diversion of water from Reading Creek for domestic use only on a parcel associated with cannabis cultivation. The point of diversion (POD) is an existing seep well with a pump on the eastside bank of Reading Creek. Diversion will adhere to a valid water right authorized by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 24, 2024, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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- 2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
- 3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
- 4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
- 6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
