Project Title: Growing Natural, LLC (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-00458-R1

Project Location (Trinity): The project is located on Barker Creek in Trinity County, CA; T32N, R11W, Section 33, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Hayfork Summit quadrangle, County Assessor's Parcel Number 015-420-16-00, 1351 Barker Valley Road, Hayfork.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2019-0458-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Nikolay Veltchev**

The project consists of the removal of an existing legacy infiltration well directly adjacent to Barker Creek. The well consists of a cistern located approximately twenty feet from Barker Creek set in the ground at a depth of approximately twelve feet. The cistern structure will be removed by winch and cable, and the cavity will be backfilled with clean washed rock. All piping and associated infrastructure will be disconnected and removed. The project will require ground disturbance and hand trimming of vegetation. No work within Barker Creek is anticipated or necessary.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on July 26, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
