Project Title: Nou Vue, CCL-343, 421 White Oak Road Cannabis Cultivation

Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) is the continuation of existing cultivation activities located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 019-410-017-00. The applicant currently holds an Adult Use – Small Mixed-Light Cannabis Cultivation License from the California Department of Cannabis Control (DCC) (CCL18-0001811, expires on 2023-11-19) and is applying for a cannabis cultivation license from the Trinity County Planning Department (CCL-343) to cultivate up to 10,000 square feet (sf) of mature outdoor canopy. The existing cultivation currently includes terraced areas for outdoor mature cultivation which include: 171 plants in 4' x 4' (2,736 sqft) raised beds, four (4) 4.5' x 80' (1,440 sqft) raised beds, 4,176 sqft total. Other structures used to support cultivation operations include a permitted groundwater well, one (1) 2,000-gallon storage tank, two (2) 6' x 33' hoopouses for immature cultivation, three (3) 10'x12' (360 sqft) and an 8'x8' (64 sqft) shed for processing, drying, administrative hold, and secured storage of pesticides and fertilizer. There are no plans for construction or expansion, and there will be no soil disturbance or construction activities. A more detailed project description can be found in the Appendix C Checklist. Special Notes: There is currently no existing solar installed on-site, power is provided by generator with plans to transition to renewable electricity via solar otherwise purchase of carbon offset credits as they become available. There is no residence on-site at this time. The site map included with Appendix C Checklist incorrectly labels the residence as an existing structure and must be updated with approx. location and dimensions of final dwelling when

delivery/installation of the new residential structure is completed in near future.



The County finds that the adoption of the proposed project falls within the Trinity County Cannabis Program Environmental Impact Report ("EIR")(SCH# 2018122049). Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR.
