Project Title: Green Sol Farm, LLC

Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (sf) of mature mixed-light cannabis located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 012-260-82-00. The applicant is seeking a Small Mixed-Light Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-508) and a Small Mixed-Light Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL19-0000202). Existing activities include the cultivation of up to 10,000 sf of mature mixed-light cannabis. The 21 existing 6'x81' hoop houses would be replaced with 8 greenhouses for mature cultivation, and the five (5) 6'x81'immature cultivation hoop houses would be replaced with two (2) immature cultivation greenhouses. These new proposed greenhouses would be located in the same area as the existing mixed-light cultivation area. Existing cannabis support infrastructure includes six (6) water storage tanks of varying capacity, a 120-sf pesticide and agricultural chemical storage area, a 225-sf cannabis compost area, a groundwater well, and a permitted septic system. Proposed support infrastructure includes a 1,500-sf processing/harvest storage area, 13 water storage tanks of varying capacity, and another 120-sf pesticide and agricultural chemical storage area. The proposed project includes use of an existing permitted groundwater well, and cultivation is irrigated via a timed drip system. Power for the project site is provided through an existing connection to Trinity Public Utility District's grid. A more detailed project description can be found in the Appendix C Checklist.

The County finds that the adoption of the proposed project falls within the Trinity County Cannabis Program Environmental Impact Report ("EIR")( SCH# 2018122049). Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR. No further environmental review is required because the County finds, based on substantial evidence in the Record of Proceedings, that approval of this project is a "later activity" associated with the Cannabis Program EIR, as defined by subsection (c) of Section 15168, in that (i)all impacts associated with the approval of this project are within the scope of environmental review previously studied, and (ii) the requirements and mitigations required by Chapter 17.43 and 17.43G of the Trinity County Code, adequately serve to mitigate the impacts associated with approval of this project.
