Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (SF) of mature outdoor canopy Cannabis Cultivation located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 017-440-036. The applicant is seeking a Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-646) and holds a Provisional Medicinal Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL20-0000365, Expires on 2024-07-10). Cultivation activities include approx. 9,400 SF of mixed-light canopy area in seven (7) 5 ft by 200 ft rows and four (4) 10 ft by 60 ft rows. An immature plant staging area (50'x70') is proposed in a previously disturbed area and will not require any additional grading or construction. Existing support infrastructure includes a 10'x10' compost area, a 10'x10' Agricultural and Chemical Storage Shed, a 10'x40' shaded drying area, a 20'x20' Processing shed and an 8'x20' shipping container for harvest storage and admin hold. The proposed project includes the use of a permitted groundwater well and Power is supplied by TPUD. There are two (2) 2,600-gallon water storage tanks, one (1) 2,500-gallon nutrient mixing tank and also a domestic use 2,500-gallon storage tank. A more detailed project description can be found in the Appendix C Checklist.

Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR.
