Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (SF) of mixed-light located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 019-630-021. The applicant is seeking a Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-098) and holds an Adult-Use Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL21-0003755, Expires on 2024-05-09). Cultivation activities include approx. 7,725 sqft of mature canopy in various sized raised beds within an approx. 10,000sqft garden area that was previously disturbed from permitted CalFire less-than-three-acre conversion. Existing support infrastructure includes a 5'x8' petroleum storage area; an 8'x8' agricultural chemical and pesticide storage area; a 12'x16' hoop house for immature canopy; a 6'x10' cannabis waste area for composting; a permitted well for both domestic and agricultural use; two (2) 2,500-gallon water tanks; and a 24'x20' garage for post-harvest processing area will become harvest storage. Power for the project is supplied by permitted on-site solar. Proposed support structures include construction of a 20'x40' building for post-harvest processing and harvest storage. SPECIAL NOTES: Applicant has provided supplemental Odor, Noise, and Light Attenuation Plan to fall in compliance with: Resolution NO. 2023-071, "A Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of The County of Trinity allowing streamlined approval of cannabis licenses that require CCVs for the calender year 2023".



The County finds that the adoption of the proposed project falls within the Trinity County Cannabis Program Environmental Impact Report ("EIR")(SCH# 2018122049). Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR. No further environmental review is required because the County finds, based on substantial evidence in the Record of Proceedings, that approval of this project is a "later activity" associated with the Cannabis Program EIR, as defined by subsection (c) of Section 15168, in that (i)all impacts associated with the approval of this project are within the scope of environmental review previously studied, and (ii) the requirements and mitigations required by Chapter 17.43 and 17.43G of the Trinity County Code, adequately serve to mitigate the impacts associated with approval of this project.
