
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-TRI-15641-R11, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, John Wright.

The project is limited to the diversion of the waters of Barker Creek for domestic use only. The point of diversion (POD) is an existing well with a pump on the eastside bank of Barker Creek. Diversion will adhere to a valid water right authorized by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on November 2, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
