**Project Title:** Green Global Farms, LLC (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TRI-42881-R1)

**Project Location (Trinity):** The project is located at Grass Valley Creek, a tributary to the Trinity River, in Lewiston, Trinity County, California; Latitude 40.681859, Longitude -122.861306; Section 26, Township 33N, Range 09W, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Lewiston U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 025-180-010-00.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-42881-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Eduardo Fernandez.

The project consists of operating, inspecting, and maintaining both water diversions, the pump and all infrastructure, and making repairs as needed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on October 19, 2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
