**Project Location (Trinity):** The project is located on an unnamed ephemeral tributary to Mad River in Trinity County, CA; T01N, R06E, Section 34, Humboldt Base and Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Sportshaven quadrangle, County Assessor's Parcel Number 018-050-67-00, 1531 Mad River Road, Mad River.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-11579-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project 8<sup>th</sup> LLC, Applicant, Nataliya Mihailova.

The project consists of two projects: 1) the decommissioning of a shallow infiltration-type well on the bank of the Mad River, and 2) the removal of legacy concrete structures within an ephemeral tributary to the Mad River.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on September 12, 2023 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
