**Project Location (Trinity):** The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Post Creek in Trinity County, CA; T30N, R12W, Section 21, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Dubakella Mountain quadrangle, County Assessor's Parcel Number 019-040-21-00, 451 Pinecone Lane, Hayfork.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (1600-2019-0457-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, **Dimitar Vaglariski**.

The parcel contains eight culverts at five locations, identified as LV-1a, LV-1b, LV-2a, LV-2b, LV-2c, LV-3, LV-4, and LV-5. Of these culverts, LV-1a, LV-1b, and LV-3 convey flow of an ephemeral tributary to Post Creek and are subject to the notification requirements of FGC Section 1600 et seq. The remaining culverts convey road runoff and/or do not contain bed, bank, or channel characteristics above inlets or below outlets. Additionally, one legacy shallow infiltration well consisting of a corrugated metal pipe (CMP) cistern is located adjacent to, but outside, the bed, bank and channel of the ephemeral tributary. The well is currently unused with no plan for future use, as a permitted groundwater well on the parcel is adequate to meet commercial cannabis cultivation needs.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on February 19, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

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1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Final EIR prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
