Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (SF) of outdoor mature canopy located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 025-140-032-000. The applicant is seeking a Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-572) and re-apply for currently expired. Adult-Use Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL19-0005027, Expired on 2022-01-13). Proposed cultivation activities include approx. 4,995sqft of mature canopy in 11 (4'x4') & 11 (5'x5') boxes; a 4'x16' bed; and a 6'x60'; 5 (6'x120') & a 6'x80' hoop houses.
