Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (SF) of outdoor cultivation located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 025-530-032-00. The applicant is seeking a Small Outdoor Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-746) and currently holds an Adult-Use Small Outdoor Provisional Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL22-0000649, Expires on 2024-09-30). Cultivation activities include up to 10,000 sf of mature canopy in (140) 4'x4' planter boxes. Existing support infrastructure includes a 10'x10' shed for agricultural and pesticide storage; a 20'x20' cannabis waste composting area; a 2,200-gallon water storage tank for agricultural use and a 2,300-gallon water storage tank for domestic use; and a 250-gallon mixing tank. Proposed reconfiguration activities include the installation of a 20'x30' building for administrative hold, packaging, post-harvest processing, and harvest storage on previously disturbed area, without grading or heavy equipment. Water will be supplied by a permitted well, Trinity PUD will supply the project's energy needs, and a permitted septic will serve for the project's wastewater needs. A more detailed project description can be found in the Appendix C Checklist.

SPECIAL NOTE:

1. Per Resolution No. 2023-071 applicant has submitted an Appendix C that scopes and offsets any additional impacts to residential receptors. A noise and light attenuation plan were not submitted as the project is outdoor and will not use any supplemental light and noise producing equipment will not be used.
2. On October 12, 2023 Trinity County Planning Commission granted approval of CCV-22-01 Initial Commercial Cannabis Variance to reduce the residential setback from the surrounding neighboring dwellings.

The County finds that the adoption of the proposed project falls within the Trinity County Cannabis Program Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") (SCH# 2018122049). Certified by the Board of Supervisors on December 21, 2020 (Resolution 2020-103). Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14) Section 15168, the impacts associated with the proposed project were studied, and mitigation measures concerning such impacts were developed, in the Cannabis Program EIR.
