Project Description: The proposed cultivation project described herein (Project) includes the cultivation of up to 10,000 square feet (SF) of mixed-light mature canopy located in Trinity County on Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 019-200-013-000. The applicant is seeking a Small Mixed-Light Cannabis Cultivation License from the County (CCL-313) and currently holds an Adult-Use Small Mixed-Light Tier 1 Cannabis Cultivation License from the Department of Cannabis Control (DCC; CCL19-0001372, Expires on 2024-12-18). Cultivation activities include approx. 9,281.8sqft of mature canopy in a 30'x77' greenhouse (with approx. 27.3'x77' canopy), a 30'x89' greenhouse (with approx. 27.3'x89' canopy), and a 30'x174' greenhouse with approx. 27.3'x174' canopy.
