Project Location (include county): The project is located at Mountain House Creek and pond, in the County of Alameda, State of California; Latitude 37.722994, Longitude -121.596000; 16850 Jess Ranch Road, Tracy CA, 95377.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-ALA-20665-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Jon Howard/Contra Costa Water District.

The project is limited to sediment removal and embankment/spillway repair on existing livestock ponds.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on 8/19/2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
