**Project Title:** Pleasanton Ridge Regional Park Pond 029 Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-ALA-41924-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is located at an unnamed stream and pond, at 3464 Old Foothill Road, in the City of Pleasanton, in the County of Alameda, State of California; Latitude 37°39'42.28", Longitude - 121°57'53.22".


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-ALA-41924-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Matt Graul/East Bay Regional Park District.

The project is limited to enhancement and repair activities of Pond PRPND029. This includes removal of unwanted sediment to improve habitat quality for amphibians, reconstruction of the embankment, and reinforcement of the spillway with rock and erosion fabric.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 8/25/2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
