
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-ALA-41940-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Robert Fletcher.

The project is limited to desedimentation and restoration of three ponds, which are scheduled for implementation between August 31 and October 31. The project designs will follow the Alameda County Conservation Partnership's wildlife-friendly pond specifications for improving habitat for the native amphibians, as well as employ avoidance and minimization measures and best management practices to avoid impact to the species during implementation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 8/25/2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
