Project Title: Hallwood Side Channel and Floodplain Restoration Project on the Lower Yuba River

Project Location: The Hallwood Side Channel and Floodplain Restoration, Phases III and IV project (Project) occurs on two private aggregate mining operations north of, and contiguous with, the Yuba River eight miles northeast of Marysville in Yuba County.


Project Description: Hallwood Side Channel and Floodplain Restoration, Phase III and IV (WCB Project ID: 2021030). The core activity of the Project is the removal of large portions of the Middle Training Wall to create a healthier, more natural, and therefore, more productive river with subsequent fine-scale grading and revegetation. The Project will restore and enhance ecosystem processes with a primary objective of rehabilitating productive juvenile salmonid rearing habitat to increase natural production of fall-run and spring-run Chinook salmon and California Central Valley (CCV) steelhead in the lower Yuba River.
