**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The City prepared an update to the Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan (BPTMP). The update provides a strategy to develop Citywide walking and bicycling networks that support connections between residential neighborhoods, schools, transit, jobs, and other services. The BPTMP includes policies, programs, and infrastructure projects to provide a holistic approach to improving active transportation.


**PROJECT BACKGROUND:** As part of the development and adoption of the 2019 General Plan the City prepared and certified the General Plan Update Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (SCH No. 2017062058). That document provides a programmatic review of the potential impacts associated with implementation of the overall General Plan. The EIR is comprised of a Draft EIR (Draft EIR) and Final EIR (Final EIR). The Final EIR was released for public review on January 4, 2019 and certified by the City Council on February 27, 2019.

This is to advise that on May 12, 2021, the City of Elk Grove City Council has approved the above-described Project and it does not alter the assumptions or analysis documented in the CEQA analysis to date. The proposed BPTMP is consistent with the analysis presented in the General Plan Update EIR and, pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15162 (Subsequent EIRs and Negative Declarations), no subsequent analysis is required. The update of the BPTMP is specified in the General Plan as Action 4.2. Additionally, the BPTMP is internally consistent with and implements the goals and policies of the General Plan by providing the plans, standards, and process for development and maintenance of bicycle, pedestrian, and trail improvements throughout the City of Elk Grove. Pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning), the BPTMP needs no further review.

Therefore, there are no substantial changes in the Project, there are no substantial changes with respect to the circumstances under which the Project is undertaken, and there is no new information of substantial importance, which was not known and could not have been known at the time of certification of the EIR, and no further environmental review is required.

- The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- A mitigation monitoring or reporting plan was not adopted for this project.
- A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
- Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
