The City of Ontario is located approximately 40 miles from downtown Los Angeles, 20 miles from downtown San Bernardino, and 30 miles from Orange County, within the County of San Bernardino. The Project site is located at the intersection of Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard.		
<p>Project Description: The City of Ontario approved the Project on June 19, 2018, adopted Resolution of Necessity No. 2018-083, and prepared an Addendum to the certified The Ontario Plan Environmental Impact Report ("Addendum"). Resolution of Necessity No. 2018-083 did not include all the necessary exhibits and attachments. To correct that ministerial error and to implement the Project approval, on June 15, 2021, the City adopted Resolution of Necessity No. 2021-055 to confirm the acquisitions sought by the City's previously adopted Resolution of Necessity No. 2018-083, including the type, scope and durations of the acquisitions sought therein for the Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard Intersection Widening Project, applying Resolution of Necessity No. 2021-055 <i>nunc pro tunc</i> (to apply the Resolution of Necessity No. 2021-055 retroactive as of June 19, 2018).</p> <p>This is to advise that the lead agency City of Ontario approved the Project on June 19, 2018, took action implementing the Project on June 15, 2021 by adopting Resolution of Necessity No. 2021-055, and has made the following determinations regarding the Project:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The City of Ontario is the Lead Agency for the Project. 2. The City of Ontario prepared the Addendum to the certified The Ontario Plan Environmental Impact Report pursuant to CEQA for the Project and approved the Project on June 19, 2018, and the Addendum reflects the independent judgment of the City of Ontario. 3. The Addendum concluded that the Project will not have a significant environmental impact on the environment and would not have any significant environmental impacts that were not previously identified in the certified The Ontario Plan Environmental Impact Report. 4. NOTICE

Each project applicant shall remit to the county clerk the environmental filing fee before or at the time of filing a Notice of Determination (Pub. Resources Code, § 21152; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subdivision (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5). Without the appropriate fee, statutory or categorical exemption, or a valid No Effect Determination issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW), the Notice of Determination is not operative, vested, or final, and shall not be accepted by the county clerk.

COUNTY DOCUMENTARY HANDLING FEE

The county clerk may charge a documentary handling fee of fifty dollars (\$50) per filing in addition to the environmental filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (e); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 753.5, subd. (g)(1)). A county board of supervisors shall have the authority to increase or decrease the fee or charge, that is otherwise authorized to be levied by another provision of law, in the amount reasonably necessary to recover the cost of providing any product or service or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee or charge is levied (Gov. Code, § 54985, subd. (a)).

COLLECTION PROCEDURES FOR COUNTY GOVERNMENTS

Filing Notice of Determination (NOD):

- Collect environmental filing fee or copy of previously issued cash receipt. (Do not collect fee if project applicant presents a No Effect Determination signed by CDFW. An additional fee is required for each separate environmental document. An addendum is not considered a separate environmental document. Checks should be made payable to the county.)
- Issue cash receipt to project applicant.
- Attach copy of cash receipt and, if applicable, previously issued cash receipt, to NOD.

If the project applicant presents a **No Effect Determination** signed by CDFW, also:

- Attach No Effect Determination to NOD (no environmental filing fee is due).

Filing Notice of Exemption (NOE) (Statutorily or categorically exempt project (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15260-15285, 15300-15333))

- Issue cash receipt to project applicant.
- Attach copy of cash receipt to NOE (no environmental filing fee is due).

Within 30 days after the end of each month in which the environmental filing fees are collected, each county shall summarize and record the amount collected on the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31) and remit the amount collected to the State Treasurer. Identify the remittance on Form No. CA25 as "Environmental Document Filing Fees" per Fish and Game Code section 711.4.

The county clerk shall mail the following documents to CDFW on a monthly basis:

- ✓ A photocopy of the monthly State of California Form No. CA25 (TC31)
- ✓ CDFW/ASB copies of all cash receipts (including all voided receipts)
- ✓ A copy of all CDFW No Effect Determinations filed in lieu of fee payment
- ✓ A copy of all NODs filed with the county during the preceding month
- ✓ A list of the name, address and telephone number of all project applicants for which an NOD has been filed. If this information is contained on the cash receipt filed with CDFW under California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 753.5, subdivision (e)(6), no additional information is required.

DOCUMENT RETENTION

The county shall retain two copies of the cash receipt (for lead agency and county clerk) and a copy of all documents described above for at least 12 months.

RECEIPT NUMBER

- # The first two digits automatically populate by making the appropriate selection in the County/State Agency of Filing drop down menu.
- # The next eight digits automatically populate when a date is entered.
- # The last three digits correspond with the sequential order of issuance for each calendar year. For example, the first receipt number issued on January 1 should end in 001. Project Location: The project site is located in southwestern San Bernardino County, within the City of Ontario. The City of Ontario is located approximately 40 miles from downtown Los Angeles, 20 miles from downtown San Bernardino, and 30 miles from Orange County, within the County of San Bernardino. The project site is located at the intersection of Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard.

Project Description: The objective of the proposed Project is to enhance the Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard intersection as identified in the traffic study prepared by Kimley-Horn and Associates for The Ontario Plan (TOP). Table 5.16-6 – Lane Geometry at Study Intersections with Recommended Improvements shows the recommended lane geometry for TOP Land Use Plan. The proposed Project enhancement will be consistent with TOP's Mobility Element System Figure M-1 and Functional Roadway Classification Plan Figure M-2.

The Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard Intersection Widening Project and related public infrastructure improvements and right-of-way acquisitions are required for and will benefit the community by widening Holt Boulevard to its ultimate configuration per TOP recommendations with the installation of additional turn lanes, thereby increasing travel efficiency on Mountain Avenue and Holt Boulevard. Holt Boulevard currently has 2 thru lanes and single left turn lanes for the eastbound and westbound direction at Mountain Avenue. The Project will provide single right turn lanes for the eastbound and westbound direction on Holt Boulevard. Mountain Avenue currently has 2 thru lanes, a single left turn lane and a single right turn lane for the northbound direction at Holt Boulevard. Mountain Avenue has 2 thru lanes, and a single left turn lane for the southbound direction. The Project will provide a single right turn lane for the southbound direction on Mountain Avenue.

The Project widening will also accommodate the future West Valley Connector Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project center bus stop along Holt Boulevard, just west of Mountain Avenue.


