Project Title: Lime Creek Road Bridge Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0122-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Lime Creek Road where it crosses over Spring Valley Creek, in the County of Calaveras, State of California; Latitude 38.19256, Longitude -120.80996 or Section 18/19, Township 04N, Range 11E, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Calaveritas, Mount Diablo Meridian (MDM).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0122-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Calaveras County Department of Public Works (as represented by Joshua Pack). The project includes the replacement of the existing Lime Creek Road Bridge over Spring Valley Creek with a new structure; located in the central portion of Calaveras County and within a rural area of the Sierra Nevada foothills.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
