PROJECT LOCATION: In the vicinity of the Camanche South Shore Recreation Area on Wade Lane in Wallace within Calaveras County and the Camanche North Shore Recreation Area on Camanche Road in Lone, within Amador County.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), as the responsible agency, will be issuing a water supply permit. The East Bay Municipal District proposed project includes the construction and operation of an ultra-filtration water treatment plant at the Camanche South Shore Recreation Area that will treat 5 million gallons per day of water from the Mokelumne aqueducts, instead of using underground wells and the Comanche Reservoir. The project will serve the Camanche South Shore Recreation Area, Camanche North Shore Recreation Area, Camanche Lake Village (Amador Water Agency) and the Wallace Community Services District (Calaveras County.) The project will also include a 6,200 foot, 12-inch diameter pipe to provide raw water from the Mokelumne aqueducts to the new treatment plant and fiber optic cable, a 13,700 linear feet 8 inch pipe to convey water from the Camanche South Shore Recreation Area to the Camanche North Shore Recreation Area, and two 1,700 gallons per minute supply pumps to provide water to the North Shore existing water storage tanks. The water treatment plant will replace two other treatment plants, without an increase in capacity.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: This is to advise that the SWRCB has issued a water supply permit **01-10-19P-004** for the above described project on **5/31/2019**, and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have significant effects on the environment.
2. A mitigated negative declaration and addendum to the mitigated negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provision of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the issuance of this permit.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted for this project.
5. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.

This is to certify that the record of permit issuance for the project is available to the general public at the Division of Drinking Water at the SWRCB's Field Office noted above. The mitigated negative declaration and addendum to the mitigated negative declaration is available from the lead agency.

The State Water Resources Control Board is a responsible agency for this project and is not responsible for the Department of Fish and Wildlife filing fees.
