Project Location (include county): The project is located in the San Joaquin River, in the County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.935100, Longitude -121.329480 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees).


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-27107-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Stockton – Municipal Utilities Department as represented by Deedee Antypas.

The project is limited to the modification of the outfall apron structure and installation of a new outfall outlet, reinstatement of the existing 60-inch reinforced concrete pipe, and the construction of a pipeline running from the Final Effluent Pump Station to the reinstated 60-inch reinforced concrete pipe.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
