Title: Regional Wastewater Control Facility Modifications Project

Applicant: City of Stockton

Location: Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Number 163-330-030, Stockton, San Joaquin County

Description: The Project would reinstate an existing 60-inch reinforced concrete pipe running from the Regional Wastewater Control Facility to the abandoned outfall apron on the east bank of the San Joaquin River, modify the outfall apron structure to create a new outfall outlet, and construct a pipeline running from the Effluent Pump Station to the reinstated 60-inch reinforced concrete pipe. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through June 5, 2043.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 5, 2023, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An  Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, City of Stockton (City), certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on October 18, 2022. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this project by the City and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating City's document.
