**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board is funding the Project referred to internally as Carpinteria Advanced Purification Project (CAPP). The Project includes the construction of an Advanced Water Purification Facility and Purified Water Pump Station to be located on the existing wastewater treatment plant site; 6,100 linear feet (LF) of 12-inch conveyance pipeline; 2,000 LF of eight-inch conveyance pipeline from the well lateral split point to individual injection wells; up to two 14-inch diameter injection wells with backwash pumps and one 42,000-gallon tank; 1,400 LF of 12-inch well backwash discharge piping to existing sanitary sewers or storm drains; and up to four monitoring wells.

**PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT:** The State Water Board has considered the Environmental Impact Report as prepared by the Lead Agency. The State Water Board has approved the Project described above on July 11, 2024. The Carpinteria Valley Water District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared and certified for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.

4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for the Project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15091.
