**Project Title:** Camino Solar Project (Western Joshua Tree Conservation Act (WJTCA) Incidental Take Permit No. 1927-ITP-2023-017-04 (ITP))

**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located in the north-central Antelope Valley on the lower foothills of the Tehachapi Mountains, in southern Kern County, California approximately 12 miles south of the City of Tehachapi and approximately 16 miles northwest of the unincorporated community of Rosamond on approximately 287 acres of private and Bureau of Land Management (BLM) administered land.

**Project Description:** This proposed Project involves the construction and operation, and maintenance of a 44 MW PV solar facility on approximately 287 acres of private and BLM land.
