Project Title: Routine Maintenance of Stream Channels and Drainage Facilities (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0152-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the City of Lincoln boundaries, covering approximately 20 miles of natural stream and channels. The project occurs within the Lincoln, Roseville, and Rocklin USGS quadrangles. The watercourses included within this Agreement include the following streams and their tributaries: Auburn Ravine, Markham Ravine, Ingram Slough, Orchard Creek, and Pleasant Grove Creek

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0152-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Lincoln, as represented by Scott Boynton.

The Project includes the routine maintenance of several streams and tributaries within the City of Lincoln. Routine maintenance activities will include the removal of debris and obstructions, sediment removal, vegetation control in channels, tree trimming to maintain the safety clearance setbacks from overhead electric lines, repair of existing erosion control works, temporary water diversions, and bridge washing, graffiti removal, and painting.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
