Project Title: Elkhorn Boulevard Extension Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-25392-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at unnamed tributaries to the West Canal in unincorporated Sacramento County, State of California; Latitude 38,673932, Longitude -121.58355; Assessor's Parcel Number 201-0291-020-6000. The project area is generally bordered by Power Line Road to the east, Airport Boulevard to the west, Meister Way to the north, and Interstate 5 to the south.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SAC-25392-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Sacramento County – Department of Airports as represented by Zachary Frese.

The project is limited to the alignment extension of Elkhorn Boulevard from Metro Air Park to Airport Boulevard, totaling a length of approximately 5,900 linear feet. The alignment extension includes various infrastructure improvements including a roundabout at Crossfield Drive, a 32-acre detention basin in the eastern portion of the site, a new traffic signal at the intersection of Power Line Road and Elkhorn Boulevard, surface improvements and a wet utility connection. Project activities include the two culverts, a stormwater tie-in, and grading activities associated with the road extension.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
