**Project Title:** United Auburn Indian Community Tribal School Pond Modification Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-14854-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project site is located at 3141 Taylor Road, Loomis, CA 95650, Placer County.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-14854-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, United Auburn Indian Community (UAIC).

The 0.973-acre irrigation pond located in the eastern portion of the property will be modified to create recreational opportunities and to provide educational/traditional gathering opportunities for the UAIC. Specific activities to modify the pond include removing existing trees (those that would interfere with construction work and access), draining water from the pond, grading and placing lining over the bed of the pond, recontouring the pond margin along the west bank to create a native planting area for native emergent wetland and seasonal wetland plants (underlined by a concrete shelf for safety), installing a new pier at the southeast end of the pond for educational and recreational uses, construction of a boat ramp, replacing the existing intake for the irrigation system, installing an aeration system to improve water quality, and installing native trees in the vicinity of the pond.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project  will /  will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
