**Project Title:** Variance TWW-2021-DF-00157 to Allow the Disposal of Treated Wood Waste under Alternate Procedures by Antelope Valley Recycling and Disposal Facility, Inc.

**Project Description:** The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC), pursuant to Section 25143 of the Health and Safety Code and Section 66260.210 of the California Code of Regulations Title 22, has issued a variance to Antelope Valley Recycling and Disposal Facility, Inc. (CAD983584046) to receive and dispose of treated wood waste from generators, authorized transporters, and/or authorized handler facilities at Antelope Valley Landfill Phases V-A, V-B and V-C. The variance allows treated wood waste to be managed under procedures different from, but equally protective to human health and the environment to, the provisions of California Health and Safety Code (HSC) Articles 6, 6.5 and 9 of Chapter 6.5 and California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Division 4.5, Chapters 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18, and/or 20. Under the terms and conditions of Variance TWW-2021-DF-00157, Antelope Valley Recycling and Disposal Facility, Inc. will ensure the treated wood waste will be appropriately managed. Because the variance activities are consistent with operations of a previously approved project, DTSC has prepared an addendum to a previously certified environmental impact report consistent with Public Resources Code 21166 and Title 14 CCR 15162-15164. The variance will expire on September 12, 2021 with possibility of extension for an additional six months.

As a Responsible Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), DTSC approved the above-described project on March 16, 2021 and has made the following determinations:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An environmental impact report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of project approval.
4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
5. Findings were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
