**Project Title:** State Route 133 Roadway Safety, Widening, and Drainage Improvement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0057-R5)

**Project Location (County of Orange):** The Project is located on State Route 133 from the junction with State Route 73 south to El Toro Road.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has amended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2020-0057-R5, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The amendment allows for the addition of 0.54 acre of temporary streambed and riparian habitat impacts to accommodate equipment and materials staging, additional work areas, and excavations for the temporary dewatering/stream diversion installation. Additionally, the amendment updated existing measures to be consistent with the current project development and eliminated several measures that are no longer applicable.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 17, 2022, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
